## Fall Early Childhood Screening- 2024

Minnesota law requires that ALL children must participate in Early Education Screening. The school district provides screening for ALL children between the ages of 3 and 5 years that have not already been screened. Although your child may be screened any time before kindergarten, it is best to do so between 3 and 4 years of age, so that any health or development concerns can be addressed sooner.

The screening will consist of the following components and will take approximately 30 minutes.

Vision & Hearing check	Family factors interview
Developmental screening	Immunization review
Physical growth assessment (height & weight)
