Early Childhood Screening

Minnesota law requires that ALL children must participate in Early Education Screening before entering Kindergarten. The school district provides screening for ALL children between the ages of 3 and 5 years of age that have not already been screened. Although your child may be screened any time before kindergarten, it is best to do so between three and four years of age, so that any health or developmental concerns can be addressed sooner.

The screening will consist of the following components and will take approximately 15-20 minutes

- 1. Vision & Hearing check
- 2. Physical growth assessment (height & weight)
- 3. Developmental screening
- 4. Exit review

Register now if your child is between the ages of 3-5 and hasn't been screened. The screening is FREE.

- •If your child is between the ages of 3-5 hasn't been screened and is on the census a letter will be sent with this infor-
- •An email will be sent at least 3 weeks before your scheduled screening date with a link to sign up for a specific time.
- •A packet will be mailed to you at least 3 weeks before your screening date. All paperwork must be completed and brought to the appointment along with a copy of birth certificate and current immunization records.
