

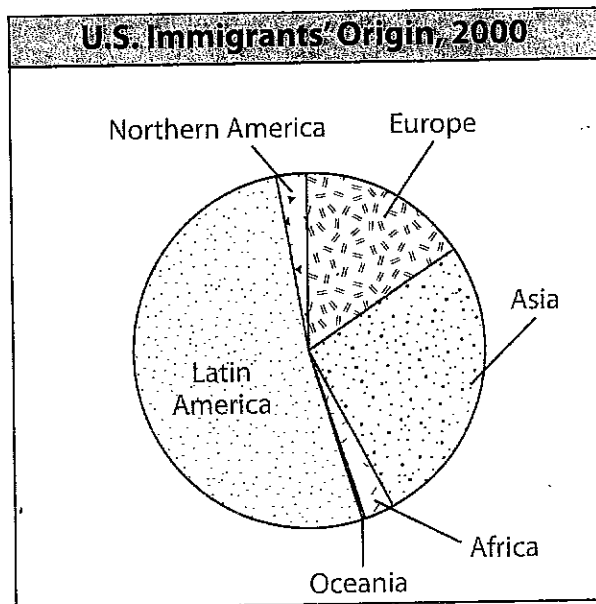
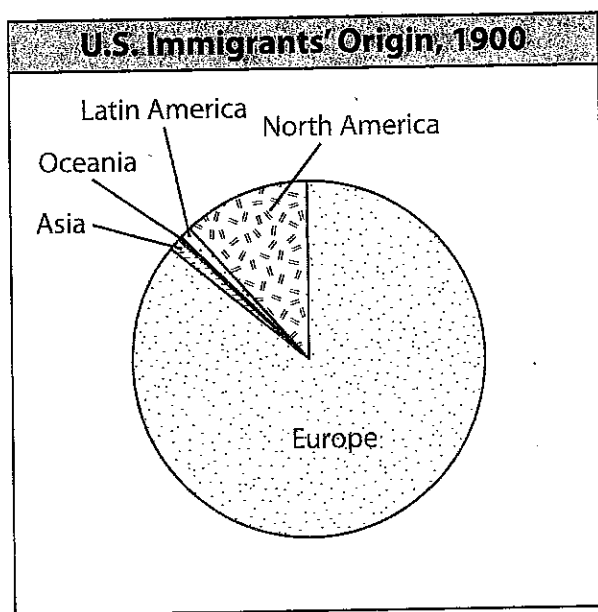


# DIFFERENTIATED INSTRUCTION ACTIVITY 1

## American Immigration

The United States was founded by people who emigrated to its eastern shores from Europe. Immigrants have continued to move to America, but the ethnicities of those coming to the nation have changed over time. The charts below help show how immigration has changed the American population.

Year	Percentage of Native Population	Percentage of Foreign-born Population
2000	88.95	11.05
1970	95.27	4.73
1940	91.19	8.81
1910	85.3	14.7
1880	86.68	13.32
