School-Owned Instrument Rental Information

There are many school-owned instruments available for students to rent during the school year. If a student is renting an instrument for the school year, they are allowed to play the instrument during all band rehearsals and performances, as well as take the instrument home to practice if desired. Students are also able to use the instrument during the summer months (not including some percussion equipment). Because of the inevitable wear and tear on an instrument being used frequently, students who are renting school-owned instruments are asked to pay a yearly fee. The rental fee money will be used to pay for all necessary repair costs for these instruments, as well as purchase new school instruments in the future. This rental fee can be paid using Pay Schools, and should be turned in to Pat Berndt in the District Office. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Mrs. Christensen or Pat Berndt.

Wind Instruments - \$60.00 per school year

Percussion Instruments - \$30.00 per school year

Reeds, valve oil, and slide oil/cream must be purchased separately. These items will be available for sale at school through Mrs. Christensen. (Checks can be written to ISD #146.) Students playing oboe, bassoon, alto saxophone, tenor saxophone, baritone saxophone, clarinet, or bass clarinet will be asked to purchase their own reeds. Oboe and bassoon reeds are \$12 each, and clarinet and saxophone reeds are \$3 each. Bottles of valve oil and slide oil/cream are \$4 each.

By paying this rental fee, I am granted unlimited access to this instrument for the 2015-2016 school year, and the following summer months.
